

Extended Services Provision

A safe place to be before and after school hours.
In secondary this is unlikely to be formal childcare but a safe place that provides:

A varied menu of study support and enrichment activities which provide fun and stimulating activities for young people. These can include "catch up" and "stretch" activities, Homework clubs, Art, dance, PE, clubs, music tuition, MFL, enterprise, museums and galleries.

These services do not need to be provided directly by the school – there can be voluntary or private sector providers.

Access to parenting support, including:

- information sessions for parents of students transferring from primary
- Signposting to national and local sources of information advice and support
- Parenting groups
- Family learning sessions

Swift and easy access to other statutory services and voluntary and community sectors to ensure that **children and additional needs are identified** as early as possible and are well **supported** through **integrated working**.
